

Eligible Limited Purpose FSA Expenses

The IRS allows certain medical, dental, vision, and related services to be reimbursed through an FSA. Below is a partial list of expenses that qualify for FSA reimbursement. Over-the-counter medications prescribed by a physician, while not listed below, are still eligible for FSA reimbursement. This list is subject to change and without notice due to new legislation.
